CCAA will award two \$250 scholarship(s) to two different High School students residing in Cass County entering his/her freshman year of college in the Fall of 2019.

- _DEADLINE: Post marked by April 1, 2019

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Student must be graduating from High School in Spring 2019 and entering his/her freshman year of college in the Fall of 2019.
2. Student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, and must include a **current transcript** as documentation. Transcript must be in sealed envelope as received from your guidance office; please allow 3-5 days for your guidance office to fulfill your request for a transcript.
3. Student must have been involved in the arts while in high school, through arts-related curriculum and/or extra-curricular activities.
4. Student must continue his/her involvement with the arts while in college.
5. Student must provide a **description of his/her volunteer activities** while in high school; preference will be given to those whose volunteer work involves the arts and/or CCAA (see attached page).

Student must **submit an essay** of 100-250 words on the topic: "How the Arts Have Influenced My Life."

6. Application must be on this authorized form only.

7. Student must include **two letters of recommendation**. Letters must be signed and must contain student's full name. Letters must have been written within the last six months and must be dated. Letters cannot be written by relatives. Teachers and faculty, employers, ministers, and representatives of organizations where students do volunteer work are all good choices from whom to request recommendation letters. Please **do not** submit more than two letters.
8. A student may receive a scholarship from another source and still be eligible to receive this award.
9. Payment of this scholarship will be made directly to the student's college or university. Student is responsible for providing complete and accurate college or university information for this purpose.
10. Completed form, letters of recommendation, essay, and most recent academic transcript from your high school should be mailed, **postmarked no later than April 1, 2019**, to:
