



Mid-North Indiana Executive Committee for Christ Scholarship Program

1. For deserving students who have graduated from an accredited Indiana high school, who are residents of **Carroll, Cass, or Clinton** Counties. The student must attend a post secondary college, university, or trade school in Indiana on a full time basis nine months or more per year, unless the trade school is for less than nine months. The school, college, or university must be licensed or accredited by a recognized accrediting agency or organization. The students should be deserving of financial assistance and likely to succeed as post-secondary, college, or university students.
2. The scholarship recipients shall be determined based on need, academic achievement, and without regard to race or gender. The scholarship award(s) shall be made based on the following criteria:
 - a. good character;
 - b. good citizenship;
 - c. above average intelligence;
 - d. good scholastic record;
 - e. recommendation from a non family member; and
 - f. financial need.
4. Applicants must upload a pdf copy of their acceptance letter and/or proof of registration in a post-secondary degree program.
5. A link to the online application is available at www.cfcarroll.org. or students can link directly to the application at: <http://howardclintoncarrollscholars.communityforce.com>. Students will create an account using an e-mail address that they check frequently and input a password. Students will follow the instructions to complete their profile.
6. The amount and number of scholarships awarded shall be at the discretion of the Carroll County Community Foundation.
7. Deadline for applying is **March 1, 2019**. Students need to use the **Mid-North Indiana Executive Committee for Christ Scholarship Application**.
