Make education a priority, not an option

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Scholarship

This is an opportunity for students to earn a \$1,000 scholarship towards their tuition. Applications are due TBD 2018. Eligibility requirements include:

- Students must be planning to enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester in the 2018-2019 academic year
- Students must be between the ages of 17 and 25 at the time of submitting application
- Demonstrate academic achievement (minimum 2.7 GPA on 4.0 scale)
- Demonstrate financial need (complete financial need form)
- Document ongoing community service involvement
- Preference given to Latino students residing in Indiana who are first generation college students

Summer Internship

This is an opportunity for students to have a 100-hour work experience in their field of study and earn a \$500 stipend towards their tuition. Applications are due TBD 2018. Eligibility requirements include:

- Open to students who are graduating high school seniors through college seniors, who are between age 18-25
- Must enroll at a college/university in the state of Indiana at least part time for fall 2018 semester
- Must participate in mandatory training on Summer 2018 DATES TBD
- Preference is given to ILI program participants

Summer Fellowship

This is an opportunity for students who are in their senior year of college or graduate students to have a 300-hour work experience in their field of study and earn a \$3,300 stipend paid directly to them. Applications are due TBD 2018. Eligibility requirements include:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above
- College senior or graduate student status in fall 2018
- Must be between age 20-26
- Must be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or DACA (must be current at time of placement)
- Must have reliable transportation, driver's license and car insurance
- Must enroll at a college/university in the state of Indiana at least part time for fall 2018 semester
- Must participate in mandatory training on Summer 2018 DATES TBD
