## WHAT IS CICF?

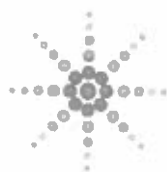

## HOW CAN I APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP? WHERE DO I BEGIN?

- ① Read our Scholarship Guidebook. You can find it online at [www.cicf.org/scholarships](http://www.cicf.org/scholarships). There you will find detailed information about each scholarship and our application process.
- ② Gather information needed to create profile for our online scholarship application portal:
  - your contact information
  - a digital copy of your transcript
  - test scores (SAT and/or ACT)
  - financial information to complete the Indiana College Cost Estimator
  - contact information for two references
- ③ Create an account by accessing our scholarship portal at [www.cicf.org/scholarships](http://www.cicf.org/scholarships).
- ④ Find a scholarship by answering eligibility questions.
- ⑤ Complete your profile.
- ⑥ Prepare all responses for essay questions.
- ⑦ Ask someone to proofread your essays before submitting them with your application.
- ⑧ Submit your application for any scholarship you are eligible for by the submission deadline.
